



This year Susan Giesbrecht will be our new leader! She has had several years of experience leading various Bible studies and is looking forward to meeting and studying together with the folks here at Linden.





### From the Chaplain's Desk

For everything, there is a season, a time for every activity under heaven. (Ecclesiastes 3:1 NLT)
