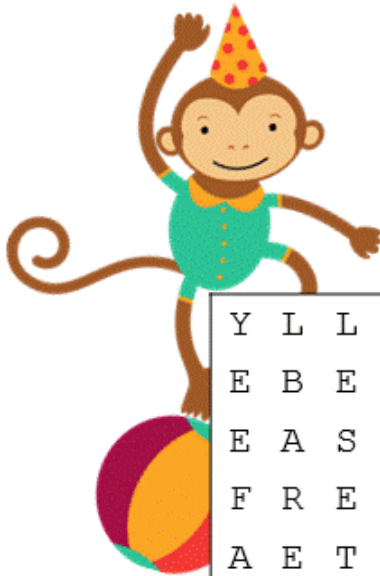

From the Chaplain's Desk

"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here; he is risen." (Luke 24:5-6, NIV)

April is here, and though the calendar told us already that spring has begun we still wait for the last snow to melt away and more sunshine to wake nature from its winter sleep. Every year around this time, we wait in anticipation for the first signs of spring. O the mystery of new leaves sprouting out of seemingly dead trees and shrubs, of green grass replacing the old dead front lawn of the past year, or the first flowers poking their heads through the black garden dirt. There is a time for everything and a season for every activity under the heavens, and spring is the most awaited time of the year.

On April 1st, we celebrate Easter, a celebration of new life, and again we celebrate Jesus' death on the cross and his resurrection on Easter morning. The story is a life-transforming one, and when we tell it to our children and grandchildren, they find it so much more compelling than any Easter Bunny tale. Many people see it, as a strange thing to believe, for the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved, it is the power of God (1Cor. 1:18).

The apostle John spoke of these things when he said, "He [Jesus] came to that which was his own, but his own did not receive him. Yet to all who did receive him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God" (John 1:11-12). But it doesn't end there. The new life we received as children of God lasts forever. Someday, when our life here on earth is over, we will be united with the One who shed his blood for us on that cross some two thousand years ago. What a day that will be!

Just like spring, Easter is all about new life, a life that never ends, promised to whoever believes. (John 3:16)
