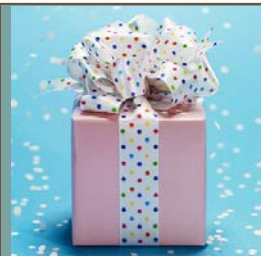

From the Chaplain's Desk

*Your wife will be like a fruitful grapevine, flourishing within your home.
Your children will be like vigorous young olive trees as they sit around your table.
That is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him. (Ps 128:3-4, NLT)*

What a beautiful picture of a flourishing family, gathering around the father and blessing him. Of course, we read that the blessing comes from the Lord "for those who fear him."

On June 17th, we will celebrate Father's Day, a day specially set apart to recognize and celebrate fatherhood. For some, this particular day will be the family celebrating with dad. Children will bring a card; others will call dad to congratulate; others gather for a family meal. Some fathers might celebrate with their sons who became fathers in the past year, and for those whose father went home to be with the heavenly Father, this day will be a day of remembrance. Father's Day is a day to celebrate, even for those who have never been a father. But all of us have a father to honor or to remember. Yes, the family is the Lord's blessing for those who fear him.

So, whichever way we celebrate Father's Day, we must find the object of our worship to be higher than our earthly relationship. As Christians, we have a Heavenly Father we celebrate. It is especially appropriate this year, since the 17th is a Sunday.

On one occasion the disciples heard Jesus pray and they were so impressed that their immediate response was, "Teach us to pray." So, Jesus taught them, and he began the Lord's Prayer with, "Our Father, who is in Heaven." The Lord's prayer became a model for worship, which includes adoration, thanksgiving, and petition – all three are ways we apply when we interact with our earthly fathers.

So, let us celebrate this year our earthly fathers on the Lord's day, June 17th. May all the fathers be blessed.
