New Soup's Hot Payment Method



Starting in January we are moving to a new payment method for our Soup's Hot program. Here's how it will work: Instead of paying Janie at the office for your meals, we will now direct bill your meals so they will be paid for when your rent is paid! Simple and easy! You will still sign up for lunch as usual - Mondays by Noon - and when you arrive for lunch you will sign your initials on the sheet provided, then the office gets the signed sheets and will process your soup payment on the same day as your rent payment, but in two separate transactions. Smoking Policy

Smoking of tobacco, cannabis and electronic cigarettes is not permitted within the apartment complex. No one may smoke cannabis or use an e-cigarette to vaporize an e-substance containing cannabis at an out-door public place, including designated smoking areas, sidewalks and outdoor parking lots. Those who wish to smoke tobacco products may do so on the tenant parking lot and must be a minimum distance of 10 meters from an entryway or air intake.

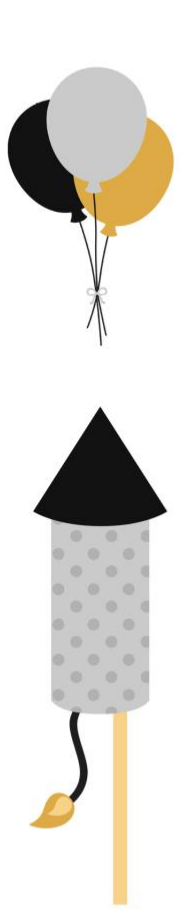
New Years' Day Communion Service

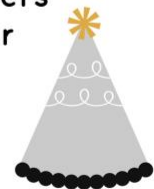
