

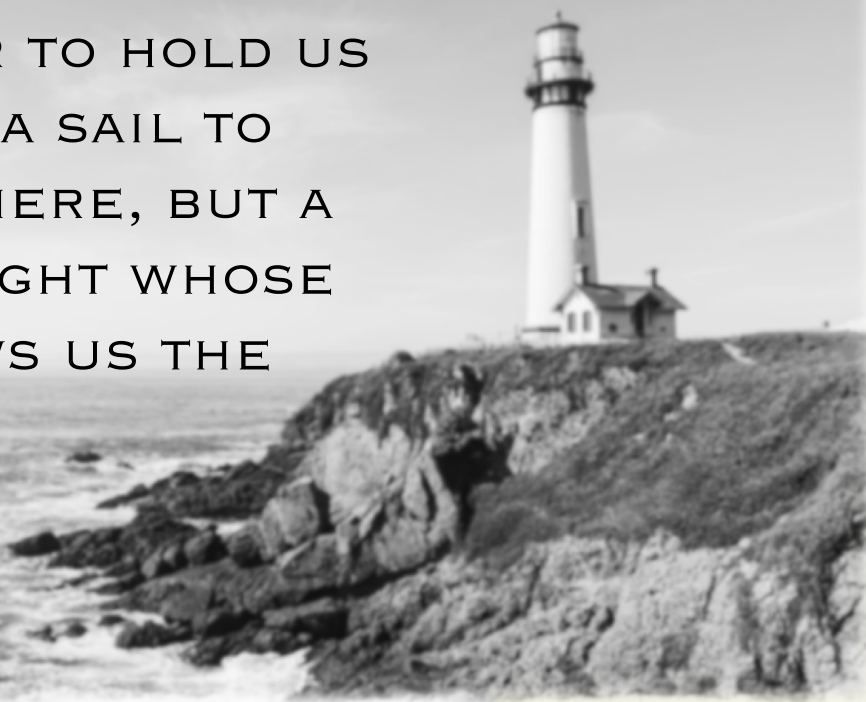

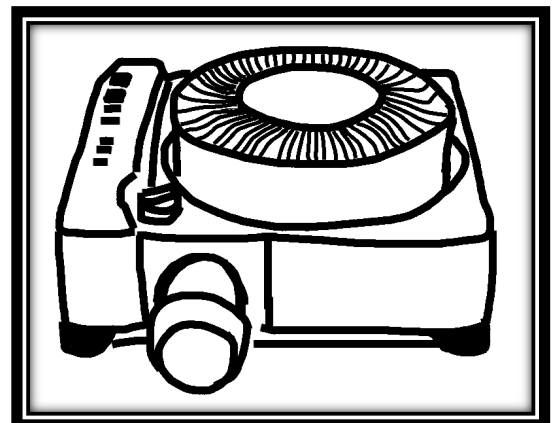

From the Chaplain's Desk

He leads me in paths of righteousness for his name's sake. (Psalm 23:3)

Sheep are foolish creatures. In fact, they are probably the most helpless animals on earth. One aspect of their helplessness is seen in the fact that they so easily wander away. No other class of livestock requires more careful handling than sheep. To the sheep, the shepherd is the guide, the provider, and the protector.

The Bible uses the image of the shepherd and the image of the father interchangeably to describe our Heavenly Father and the love and care he provides for us. Both models describe loving and compassionate care, provision, and protection we can and do expect from God. He is the one who offers himself up for his flock or family. "*Greater love has no one than this, that someone lay down his life for his friends*" (John 15:13). He also wants us to grow spiritually, so he leads us and teaches us along the way.

In today's verse, David says, "*He leads me on the path of righteousness for his name's sake.*" The underlying sense is "right-standing" or even more simply, "being right" with God and the people around us. The key is that God leads us, and thus, we can walk in confidence and trust. The Christian walk with God as the shepherd or father is one of *childlike faith* and humility.

Being a father who provides care for his family after the example God gives us in Scriptures, is a position of humility and great responsibility – humility towards God as his guide and also toward the family as he leads them in righteousness and cares for them.

As we celebrate Father's Day this year, let us remember the care our fathers provide or have provided for us in the image of God the Father and Great Shepherd. Let us thank God for our fathers, who led us in righteousness and made us the people we are today.
