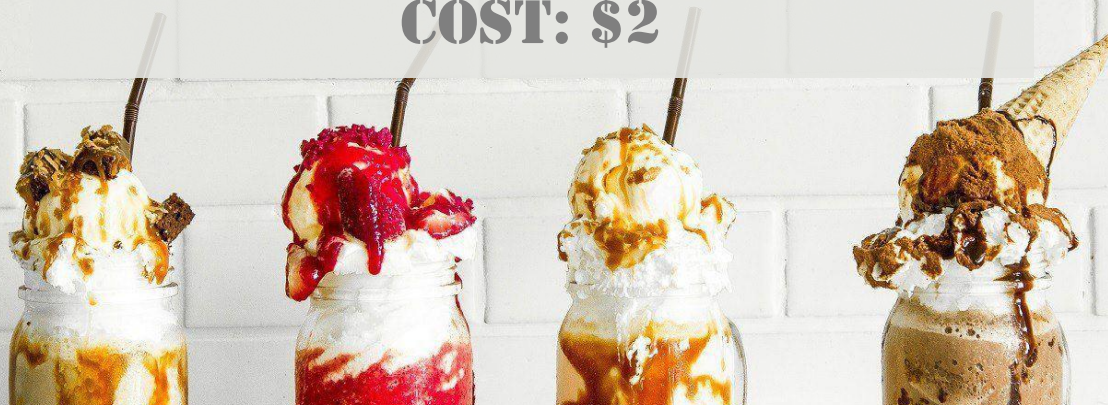

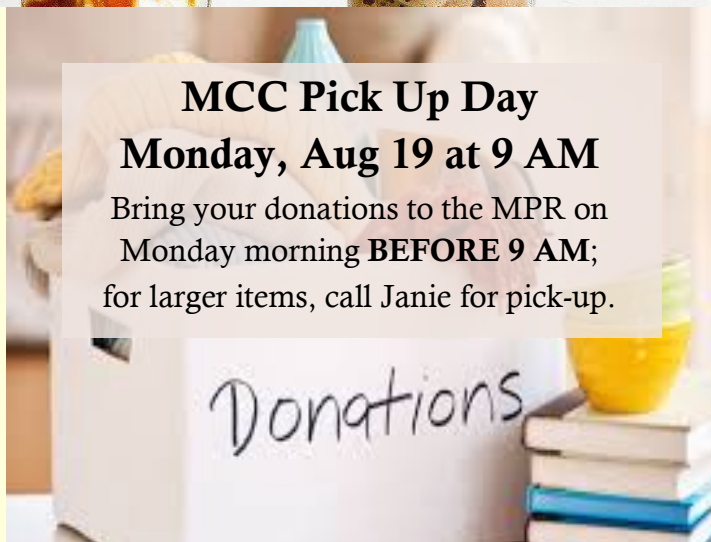

## From the Chaplain's Desk

*When I look at your heavens, the work of your fingers, the moon and the stars, which you have set in place, what is man that you are mindful of him, and the son of man that you care for him? (Psalm 8:3-4 ESV)*

When was the last time you stood outside and looked at a starry night sky? It has been for me quite a while, too. Nowadays, we have to leave the city and drive out somewhere into the fields to be able to see the moon and the stars in their full beauty. City lights, pollution, and noises around us have almost drowned out the beauty of God's creation when we live in the city.

Imagine the scene. Here is David, out in the field under the stars watching his sheep. The stars were brilliant and the full moon crossed the sky. He felt as we have all felt as we have stood under the stars at night, a mixture of mystery and awe as he looked up into the star-sprinkled heavens. As he pondered, the inescapable question came to him. "What is man", he asked himself, "in the sight of the God who created all this and why would God care for me?"

David goes on to answer his own question in verse five: "*Yet, you have made him a little lower than the heavenly beings and crowned him with glory and honour*". Man is a unique being and has a unique relationship with God. Being made in His image means that God wants to live through man. You and I are made to be the manifestation of God's life on earth, the vehicle through which God chose to become visible to all creation.

God created human beings to be fully alive in union with Him. Are we allowing God to restore that union with the risen Christ to be fully alive in and through us?
