## From the Chaplain's Desk

*Do you not say, 'There are yet four months, then comes the harvest'? Look, I tell you, lift up your eyes, and see that the fields are white for harvest. (John 4:35 ESV)*

Harvest time has begun. As I drive home from work, I see fields that are almost ready to be harvested, some are even empty already. I love the appearance of ripe fields, the activity of big machinery in the fields, the smell of hay and straw. Farmers prepare for harvest the whole year.

The machinery is repaired and prepared in winter. The seeds are planted in spring and cultivated and irrigated, if necessary, in summer. All the work is for one purpose: to reap a bountiful harvest. This is the time where all other work has to wait – harvest has the highest priority.

In John 4:1-45, we read about Jesus' witness to a woman from Samaria after which he taught his disciples about the mission work they were about to begin. He begins with a rephrase of the proverb that a farmer has to wait after seeding four months for the harvest (vs.35), and he argues that the time for harvest was now. The disciples were in for a real-life-illustration of the Lord's teaching. Because of the woman's testimony, many of her fellow citizens believed (vs.39), and because Jesus stayed for two days, many more believed that He "was indeed the Savior of the world" (vs.41-43).

We live in a world that presents itself with many ideas, world views, and religions. It is not much different than in Jesus' day. The Bible is clear about the importance of the mission and our involvement in it. So, in your family, neighborhood, the circle of friends, where do you see an urgency to harvest? What will you do? When will you start?

Father, give us the courage to walk through doors you will open for us and do our part in your plan of salvation.

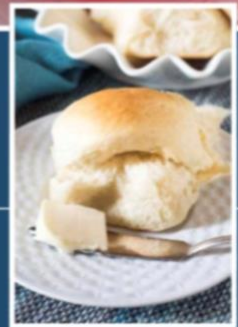
