From the Chaplain's Desk

Have mercy on me, my God, have mercy on me, for in you, I take refuge. I will take refuge in the shadow of your wings until the disaster has passed. (Psalm 57:1 NIV)

Summer is here, and so is the time of sitting outside, going for walks, enjoying fellowship with friends and family in the shade of the big trees on our little back yard, while the grandkids play on the play structure and kiddy pool. It is interesting, how few things children need to be content and happy.

As my mind wanders back to my childhood, I remember biking with friends to the little dugout not far from our village, to swim and refresh after the chores at home were done, or even playing outside in the summer rain. I also remember the refreshing showers sometimes turning into intense thunderstorms, so forceful that we children had to hide somewhere until the storm was over before we could go home.

David wrote Psalm 57 when he hid in a cave from a storm in his life. Saul was after him and threatened his life. David likened God's protection to the safeguard of the wings of a bird. I can't help but visualizing a mother hen gathering her chicks under her wings, protecting them from a lurking predator.

The phrase "*shadow of your wings*," occurring in Psalm 57:1, is also in Psalms 17:8, 36:7, 61:4, and 63:7. In Psalm 91:1 the phrase becomes "*shadow of the Almighty*," and verse 4 of the same psalm says, "*He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings, you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.*"

As we go through life, storms will assail and subside, be in illness, death, finances, or any tension in life, the best place to be is in the shadow of God's wings. And so, Jesus calls you and me, "*Come with me by yourselves to a quiet place and get some rest*" (Mark 6:31).

May you be surrounded by His peace.

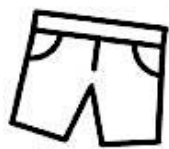
