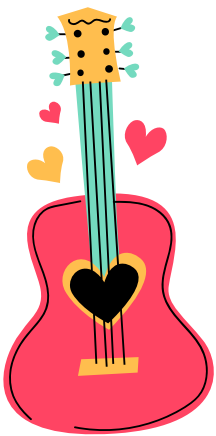

“And the One seated on the throne said, ‘Behold, I make all things new!’” Revelation 21:5



Christianity is, in many ways, a celebration of new life. A faithful rejoicing in the fact that, though indeed we have fallen into evil of all sorts, through the gift of Christ we and the whole creation are being made new! (Rom. 8:18-23.) Our great hope is everlasting, resurrection life with God in the coming new creation (1 Cor. 15; Rev. 21:1-5). Indeed, we are told that when we believe in and obey Christ, here and now, we become little pieces of that new creation already (2 Cor. 5:17), anticipating the fulfillment of that reality in the life of the age to come.



But what about those times when our lives don't look like a new creation in Christ at all? What about those times we still live like the “old man” we are supposed to have put off? Well, those are times when we can say with the Prophet, “The steadfast love of the Lord never fails. His mercies never come to an end, but are new every morning; great is Your faithfulness.” (Lam. 3:22-23.) We are given the power to turn that key and truly repent by the Holy Spirit dwelling in us. And “when we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us and cleanse us from all unrighteousness.” (1 Jn. 1:9).



We are already made new in the love of Christ, and we can live into that newness which is our life in him through repentant faith. The beginning of each new year reminds us that God blesses us graciously with the gift of many new moments to repent.

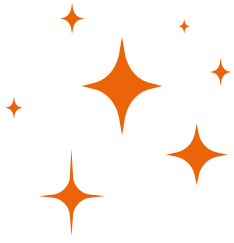
