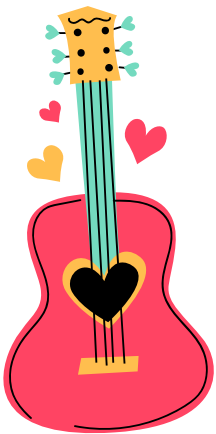

## From the Chaplain's Desk

*“Therefore, the LORD God sent man forth from the garden of Eden...” Gen. 3:23*

Genesis 3 famously contains the story of humanity's “fall” from grace and into sin. The first sin in taking the forbidden fruit casts man and women from the Garden paradise into the world we know today. To bar any chance of their return, God even places cherubim (a type of angel) with a flaming, spinning sword at its east gate. The expulsion from paradise is often seen as an act of God's judgement, and indeed it contains that as well. But if we read the verses which come immediately beforehand, we see that it is also a greater act of His mercy:

“Then the LORD God said ‘See, the man has become like Us, knowing good and evil; and now he might reach out his hand and take from the Tree of Life, and eat, and live forever’ – therefore the LORD God sent man forth...” It was to keep humanity, in their new sinfulness, from eating of the Tree of Life and becoming eternally stuck in that evil state that God casts them from the Garden. God created humanity out of pure love, and would not consent to His beloved creation becoming eternally marred by evil. Thus, He banishes them from the source of eternity until a way of salvation can be made. God Himself makes this way in the incarnation, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. The Cross of Christ has become the new Tree of Life, and now all who eat of its spiritual fruit properly, by faith and repentance, have a share in the paradise of God. To preserve humanity God bars them from eternity; to save them, He reopens that way by the blood of Christ.

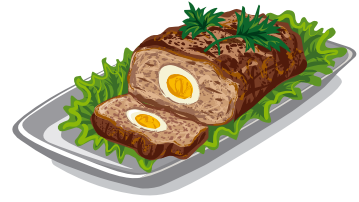
### **New Hire for Haven Group**
