From the Chaplain's Desk

"...we take every thought captive to make it obedient to Christ..." 2 Cor. 10:5

Have you ever been in a situation, perhaps falling asleep at night, when suddenly the most horrendous thought appears in your mind? An image, or perhaps a temptation? And you wonder, 'Where on earth did that come from?' I certainly have, and if you've shared that experience, your next thoughts are probably, 'Where in me did that come from?' The answer may surprise you, but it didn't come from in you at all.

In the way the Bible understand things, the human mind is not just the brain. Our ability to think is ultimately a power of our soul. The Greek word for mind is Nous. The Nous (Mind) does not create thoughts. People don't create thoughts. Instead, the Nous (Mind) is our spiritual organ of perception. It is what allows us to take in information from the worlds around us (physical and spiritual) and then make sense of that information. But we know that in the worlds around us there are many evil forces at work. Thus, our Nous (Mind) is constantly being bombarded by evil things. But that's just the point: While our minds are being bombarded by evil things, we are not generating those things. We have the ability to reject them, to say no.

They come from outside us.

The trouble is, in our sin-sick state, our defences have fallen down. We welcome sinful thoughts from outside, rather than rejecting them. We let them take root, and overtake us. Thanks be to God, part of our salvation is that we now have 'the Mind of Christ.' In His power we can truly take every thought captive, rejecting the evil and embracing the good. Our defences are being rebuilt day by day in the power of the Holy Spirit. In Him, you have the strength to say no.

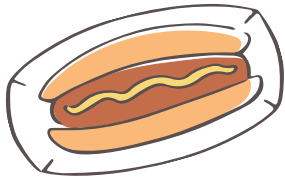

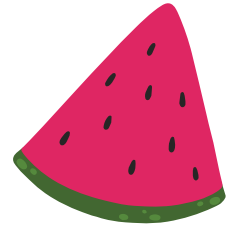
