From the Chaplain's Desk

"'As I live,' says the Lord, 'every knee shall bow to Me, and every tongue shall confess to God.'" Isaiah 45:23

The month of August is named for the ancient Roman ruler Octavian (27 BC – 14 AD), adopted son of Julius Caesar. Octavian is better known today by his royal name: Caesar Augustus. Augustus is widely considered to be the first true Roman emperor. ('Augustus,' by the way, means something like 'The glorious one.' A humble title.) Augustus is also famous for being the emperor reigning at the time when Christ was born (see Luke 2:1).

During Augustus' reign, the Roman senate voted in favour of elevating his deceased father Julius to the status of a Roman god. Julius received his own temple, offerings, and priesthood. This had the knock-on effect of also making Augustus a 'son of a god,' a fact which he worked to great effect, emblazoning the title on coins and monuments. (Augustus would be elevated to 'god' status himself shortly after his own death.)

No matter how grand the titles, heirs, or achievements, however, (even having a month named after you!) today Augustus is an artefact of history. His kingdom has come to an end. Christ, however, the true Son of the true

God, continues to reign, and His kingdom shall have no end. The early Christians used a lot of words from the royalty of their day when describing the events surrounding Jesus. Even the word 'Gospel' itself comes from the world of the Caesars. It was used to announce whenever the king had won a great victory. Christ, the ultimate King, has won the ultimate victory over sin, death, and the devil, and so we still go on preaching His Gospel to this day.

People are still becoming citizens of His kingdom, world without end.

- 2. Take cover under solid furniture or a mattress (if #1 is not possible)
