From the Chaplain's Desk

"Jesus came into Galilee, preaching the gospel of the Kingdom of God and saying, 'The time is fulfilled, and the Kingdom of God is at hand. Repent and be faithful to the gospel."

Mark 1:14-15

While the new calendar year officially begins in January, September often marks a kind of mini 'new year' in all our lives. The end of Summer and coming of Fall is a transition we all take note of and feel in different ways. These transition moments are a gift from God. They give us the opportunity to take stock, to look back, and to make changes. That's really what the word 'repent' means: To make a change. Literally, to turn around. It's not a gloomy thing or a judgemental one. It's a chance to see what's been going wrong in your life, and have the freedom in Christ to turn away from it and walk the other direction. To make amends and start over. The two parts of repentance that Jesus mentions in this verse, turning away from sin ('repent') and walking in the other direction ('be faithful to the gospel') are the content of the Christian life. And we're promised that, if we do that, we are already tasting the Kingdom of God.

This is one of the best-kept-secrets of the Christian faith, but it shouldn't be. Christ is the Kingdom of God. Where He is, there the Kingdom is. When we live our lives in Christ, repenting, obeying His commandments, and being faithful to Him as our King, we are already in the Kingdom! Every prayer, every righteous act, every generous or loving moment, every time you repent (Rom. 14:17), you are being brought right up to the threshold, the borderland between the Kingdom of God and the world! "The Kingdom of God is within you (Lk. 17:21.)"
