

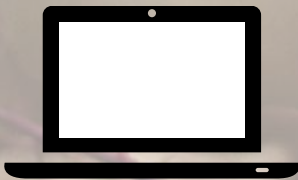

6th Floor - 11:00-11:30

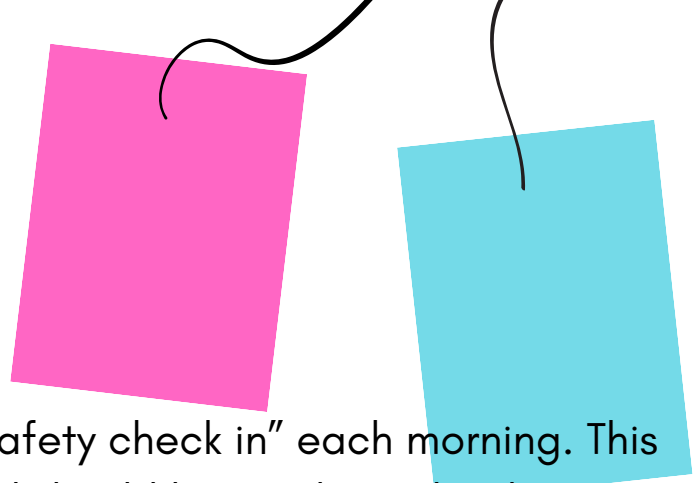

SAFETY CHECK REMINDERS



The pink tag program is in place to be a “safety check in” each morning. This is not necessarily a fail-safe program, and should be used as a backup to friends and/or family checking in on you.

Please DO NOT hang your tag out the night before, as this negates the purpose of the safety check program. If you regularly do this, the program cannot properly serve its purpose for you and safety checkers are left unsure about your safety.

If you currently participate in the pink tag program, but are not finding the service currently beneficial to you, please let Myka (TRC office) know, so she can temporarily suspend your participation. Additionally, if you receive a daily check in by Home Care each morning, this can replace your participation in the pink tag program.

From the Chaplain's Desk:

"He must increase, but I must decrease." John 3:30

John the Baptist serves as the great forerunner to the coming of Christ. It was John's task to 'prepare the way of the Lord' and to 'make His paths straight' (Mark 1:3). John was to warn and prepare the people of Israel for the coming of Christ. Considered a great man by many who flocked to be baptized by him, hear his preaching, and imitate his way of life, it may have been tempting for someone with less spiritual strength than John to accept their adulation, to be puffed up with pride. But John spent his days working out his 'own salvation with fear and trembling' (Phil. 2:13) practicing a severe but incredibly holy way of life. As a result, he was able to see things as they truly stood, and his place in God's purposes. When the time came, and Christ was revealed to the world, John did not struggle with jealousy or a sense of his place 'being overtaken' by someone else. Instead, he rejoiced!

"I am not the Christ, but I have been sent before Him. He who has the bride is the bridegroom; but the friend of the bridegroom, who stands and hears him, rejoices because of the bridegroom's voice. Therefore this joy of mine is complete...He who comes from heaven is above all; he who is of earth is earthly and speaks of the earth." John 3:28-31.

Because John struggled all his life to obey the commandments of God, he was able to humbly lay himself aside and place all his joy and pride in Christ alone. Let us likewise struggle at faithfulness, that we might not only see ourselves rightly, humbly in the world, but have similar joy that while we are small, Christ is "above all"!
