

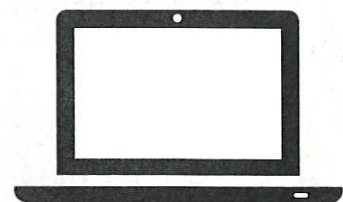

## *From the Chaplins Desk*

“...I will pour out My spirit on all flesh...” (Read Acts 2:1-41)

Pentecost Sunday falls on the Christian calendar somewhere between May 28 and June 4, depending on the date of Easter that year. The timing is based on the Jewish festival (Lev. 23:15-16) which always took place fifty days after Passover (‘Pentecost’ is Greek for ‘Fifty’). From the gospels we know that Christ was crucified on Passover, so Christians celebrate Pentecost fifty days after Easter Sunday.

The original festival was one of thanksgiving to God for the first fruits of a new harvest. So it’s fitting that this festival was the time when God chose to pour out the Holy Spirit upon all His people, beginning the life and ministry of His Church. Its seeds had all been planted, watered, and begun to grow, and now was the time to celebrate the beginning of the harvest. And Luke makes it clear, it was a good crop! About 3,000 souls were baptized that day. The first taste of literally billions more to come in the following centuries.

Another key aspect of the Pentecost story is the apostle’s sudden ability to speak the Gospel in other languages (v.4-12). This is a direct reversal of the incident at Babel (Gen. 11:1-9) when God descended to confuse the languages of sinful humanity. Now the human family is being rejoined, both to God and to one another, through “the wonderful works of God (v.11)” wrought in Christ (v.16-36). The gift of the Spirit to all people was something completely new, as before this it was only given to select priests, prophets, and kings for their particular ministries. But now the whole Church is a “nation of priests (Rev. 1:6),” and “a temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 6:19).”
