What is Truth and Reconciliation Day?

September 30, 2021, marked the first National Day for Truth and Reconciliation, a day that coincides with Orange Shirt Day. It recognizes the tragic legacy of residential schools, the missing children, the families left behind and the survivors of these institutions.



"But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peace-loving, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without favouritism or hypocrisy." James 3:17

Wisdom is the gift of God. All true wisdom comes from Him, for he is the "way, the truth, and the life" of all things. The apostle James tells us that the qualities of this kind of heavenly wisdom are seen in the living of virtuous lives. That may sound a bit different from the kind of 'wisdom' we're used to thinking about, at least in the way the world around us defines wisdom. In that definition, wisdom means knowing lots of things, lots of head-knowledge with the ability to apply that knowledge to the various situations of life. A wise person is someone who has studied lots, been to university, has a wide experience of the world.

All those things may well contribute to a degree of wisdom (or they may not!), but that isn't exactly what James has in mind here. While study and life experience are good, even better is experience and study of the virtues! Purity, peace-lovingness, gentleness, a willingness to yield and give up our own way to others, mercy, not showing favouritism or being a hypocrite. These are the things which real wisdom, the heavenly wisdom, are made of. This is the case because, ultimately, they are the attributes of Jesus Christ, who is the wisdom of God incarnate in human flesh (please read 1 Cor. 1:18-2:16). If we are to become more like Jesus, it means we are to become more full of the heavenly wisdom, the wisdom of love, prayer, and purity.
